Scope 3 Carbon Footprint: **8.47m tCO2e**

Carbon Footprint: **63% reduction**

- Our Priority Interventions:**
- 1) Phase out fossil fuel boilers
 - 2) Reduce embodied carbon of goods sold
 - 3) Improve energy efficiency of goods sold
 - 4) Switch to lower impact refrigerants
 - 5) Decarbonise Scope 3 transportation

Lobby Government: for accelerated plans & support for low carbon heating solutions.

Supplier Webinars Launched: Support suppliers to understand and calculate carbon and set their own targets.

Interim Target: 70% of Group spend with centrally-managed suppliers of products for resale to be with suppliers who have calculated their Scope 1 & 2 carbon and set their own carbon reduction target by end of 2024.

40% of spend on products backed by EPDs*.

100% of spend on products backed by EPDs*.

Scope 3 Carbon Internal Working Group Formed.

Formal letter to all suppliers: outlining our NZC plans and Scope 3 target and requesting support.

Review & Revise Supplier Commitment on Carbon.



Internal BSS Carbon Focus group launched: accelerating BSS NZC Scope 3 plans.

New Online Risk Assessment questions: asking for Carbon Roadmaps and SBT approved targets.

Note: Legislation change - No gas boilers in new domestic buildings.

Note: No new gas boilers installations by 2035.

Scope 3 Reassessment conducted annually.

Automated Customer Carbon Reports: Providing customers with delivery carbon.

Embodied Carbon: Key products listed with 'Price' and 'Embodied Carbon' (where available) on our websites and catalogues.

Scope 3 Working Group: This group will be focusing on the products and services that TP Group will be offering to reduce carbon in our supply chain.
